We engaged over 120 of San Francisco's Schools



In the 2023–2024 school year, **81.6% of** SFUSD schools participated in the Safe Routes to School program.

That's 58 elementary schools, 11 middle schools, 9 high schools, and 6 other types of public schools. Additionally, more than 40 charter and

private schools also participated in Safe Routes to School programming.

Even better, almost all the Focus Schools (schools chosen to get extra help based on safety and community needs) participated too-31 out of 33 schools!
